FOREST TRAILS, BEACH WALKS AND KAYAKING TRIPS

Vamizi Island is home to a great variety of flora and fauna. A number of trails will take guests through the coastal forest and along the beach, stopping off in deserted sandy coves for a cooling swim. On the way, look out for Samango monkeys and giant coconut crabs as well as a multitude of forest and coastal birds. Estuary kayaking provides a different way to see the wildlife - the water beneath the boat is often so clear that you can see fish and coral whilst meandering through the mangrove trees in search of kingfishers and green herons.

PICNICS

Picnics can be arranged in various deserted locations around Vamizi. The ultimate desert island experience - in luxury, of course!

SEA KAYAKS, HOBIE CAT & DINGHY SAILING

Guided or solo kayaking adventures take you through the mangrove-lined estuary and out onto the shallow reef beyond. Hobie Cats and dinghies are also available for those who want to feel the wind in their hair.

SMALL DHOW SAILING

Vamizi has a traditional sailing boat called a Dhow on which you can enjoy a Sundowner Cruise and see the play of the dying light on the water and land. This is a beautiful way to see out the day with a glass of chilled wine.

TURTLE WATCHING AND RELEASING

Vamizi is home to Green and Hawksbill turtles. The turtles come up onto the beach to nest and guests, if lucky enough to be there in season, can watch this amazing sight. When the eggs hatch some baby turtles may be trapped in the sand. These stragglers are saved and released by the Conservation Team; this is a fantastic activity for children to be involved in.

COMMUNITY VISITS

Visits to the local communities can be made to experience the lifestyles, customs and traditions of the island's community.

SNORKELLING FROM THE SHORE

There is good snorkelling to be had close to the shore around the myriad of coral heads. Masks, fins and snorkels are available free of charge at the Dive Centre.

WHALE WATCHING AND DOLPHIN WATCHING

Boat trips to watch humpback whales are available in season - usually from July to September but sometimes as late as November. Dolphins can usually be seen year round.

DIVING

A marine survey has identified more than 400 species of fish and a great diversity of unbleached coral reefs around Vamizi. Our dive sites cater for all abilities, from shallow dive sites for beginners to vertical wall dives for the more experienced diver.

FISHING

Vamizi offers world-class deep sea fishing. For keen blue water fishermen, the vertical drop off beyond the reef teems with game fish, including wahoo, giant trevally, yellowfin tuna and sailfish.

WELLNESS AND HOLISTIC TREATMENTS

Massages and beauty treatments are available and carried out in the privacy of your own kitala. Treatments can be arranged upon request on arrival at Vamizi.

SNORKELLING FROM A MOTORBOAT

Vamizi's coral reefs offer a plethora of amazing life to see under the surface. The best snorkelling sites around the island are only accessible by boat.
